


What's next

 - General capabilities: Literacy, numeracy, critical and creative thinking, personal and social capability, ethical understanding, intercultural understanding






The Learning Environment



Continuation of learning (2 years of Pre-School)

What are the benefits?

- School readiness
- Smooth transition to primary school
- Social and emotional regulation
- Rich language exposure and mastery
- Child agency is established





Kindy 2020

Continuation of learning (2 years of Pre-School)

How does the program support children's school readiness?

- Child readiness vs 'system readiness'
- Confidence and sense of identity
- Prior understanding of 'school' traditions, routines and rituals
- Developmental needs are tracked and supported





Kindy 2020

- Full kindergarten program available (4-5-year old's)
- Individualized learning plans to suit the needs and interest of each child
- Fully equipped facilities (art studio, multi-purpose-built learning spaces, sensory and nature playground, quiet and active spaces)
